

1. How should we feel when we sin?

When we sin, we should feel s\_\_\_\_\_ that we have disobeyed God and want to turn from our sin because we love Him.

2. All the people of Israel gathered together in the square by the **Water** Gate. (Nehemiah 8:1)

3. For a fourth of the day they stood where they were. And they **read** from the Book of the Teachings of the Lord their God. Then they spent another fourth of the day **confessing** their sins. And they **worshiped** the Lord their God. (Nehemiah 9:3)

4. “Blessed be your wonderful **name**.

It is more wonderful than all blessing and praise. . (Nehemiah 9:5)

5. “You are the Lord God. You chose **Abram**. You brought him out of U\_\_ of the Babylonians. You named him **Abraham**. (Nehemiah 9:7)

6. “You saw our ancestors suffering in **Egypt**. You heard them cry out at the **Red Sea**. (Nehemiah 9:9)

7. You led our ancestors with a pillar of **clouds** in the daytime.

And you led them with a pillar of **fire** at night. (Nehemiah 9:12)

8. You told them about your holy **Sabbath**. You gave commands, orders and teachings to them through your servant Moses. (Nehemiah 9:14)

9. When they were hungry, you gave them **bread** from heaven. When they were thirsty, you brought them **water** from the rock. (Nehemiah 9:15)

10. They refused to listen. They **forgot** the miracles you did for them.

They became stubborn and turned against you. They chose a leader to lead them back to their slavery. But you are a **forgiving** God. You are **kind** and full of **mercy**.

You do not become **angry** quickly. And you have great **love**. So you did not **leave** them. (Nehemiah 9:17)
