

**1Corinthians 13:4-13 ICB**

<sup>4</sup> Love is p\_\_\_\_\_ and k\_\_\_\_\_. Love is not j\_\_\_\_\_, it does not b\_\_\_\_\_, and it is not p\_\_\_\_\_. <sup>5</sup> Love is not r\_\_\_\_\_, is not s\_\_\_\_\_, and does not become a\_\_\_\_ easily. Love does not remember w\_\_\_\_\_ done against it. <sup>6</sup> Love takes no pleasure in e\_\_\_\_, but rejoices over the t\_\_\_\_\_. <sup>7</sup> Love patiently accepts all things. It always t\_\_\_\_\_, always h\_\_\_\_\_, and always continues s\_\_\_\_\_.

<sup>8</sup> L\_\_\_\_ never ends. There are gifts of p\_\_\_\_\_, but they will be ended. There are gifts of speaking in different languages, but those gifts will e\_\_\_\_\_. There is the gift of k\_\_\_\_\_, but it will be ended. <sup>9</sup> These things will end, because this knowledge and these prophecies we have are not complete. <sup>10</sup> But when p\_\_\_\_\_ comes, the things that are not complete will end. <sup>11</sup> When I was a c\_\_\_\_\_, I talked like a c\_\_\_\_\_; I thought like a child; I made plans like a child. When I became a m\_\_\_\_\_, I stopped those childish ways. <sup>12</sup> It is the same with us. Now we see as if we are looking into a dark m\_\_\_\_\_. But at that time, in the future, we shall see clearly. Now I know only a part. But at that time I will know fully, as God has known me. <sup>13</sup> So these three things continue forever: f\_\_\_\_\_, h\_\_\_\_ and l\_\_\_\_\_. And the greatest of these is l\_\_\_\_\_.
