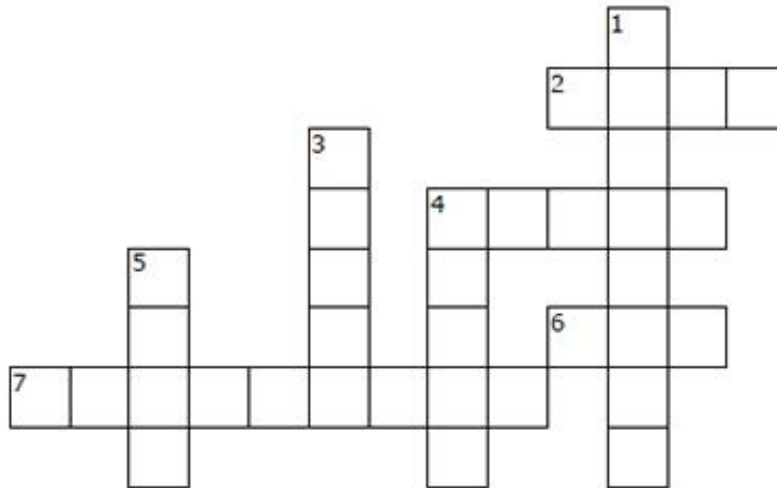


Paying Taxes to Caesar
