9. The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom you put to death by hanging Him on a c\_\_\_\_\_. (Acts 5:30)
10. He is the one whom God exalted to His right hand as a P\_\_\_\_\_ and a S\_\_\_\_\_, to grant repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. (Acts 5:31)
11. And we are w\_\_\_\_\_ of these things; and so is the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey Him. (Acts 5:32)
12. But he was pierced because of our r\_\_\_\_\_, crushed because of our i\_\_\_\_\_; punishment for our peace was on him, and we are healed by his wounds. (Isaiah 53:5 CSB)
