1. ² A _____, the high priest, heard this and told the men who were standing near Paul to hit him on his mouth. (Acts 23:4)
2. ³ Paul said to Ananias, "God will hit you too! You are like a wall that has been p_____ w_____.! You sit there and judge me, using the law of Moses. But you are telling them to hit me, and that is against the law." (Acts 23:4)
3. ⁵ Paul said, "Brothers, I did not know this man was the high priest. It is written in the Scriptures, 'You must not curse a l_____ of your people.'" (Acts 23:5)
4. (The Sadducees believe that after people die, they cannot live a_____. The S_____ also teach that there are no angels or spirits. But the Pharisees believe in them all.) (Acts 23:8)
5. ⁹ So there was a great uproar. Some of the teachers of the law, who were P_____, stood up and argued, "We find nothing wrong with this man! Maybe an angel or a spirit did speak to him." (Acts 23:9)
6. ¹¹ The next night the Lord came and stood by Paul. He said, "Be b_____! You have told people in Jerusalem about me. You must do the same in R_____ also." (Acts 23:11)
7. In the morning some of the Jews made a plan to k_____ Paul. They made a promise that they would not eat or drink anything until they had killed him. ¹³ There were more than _____ Jews who made this plan. (Acts 23:12)
8. ¹⁶ But Paul's n_____ heard about this plan. He went to the army building and told Paul about it. (Acts 23:16)
9. ²³ Then the commander called two officers. He said to them, "I need some men to go to C_____. Get 2_____ soldiers ready. Also, get 7__ horsemen and 2_____ men with spears. Be ready to leave at nine o'clock tonight. (Acts 23:23)
