4. The people of Israel did what the Lord said was wrong. They f\_\_\_\_\_ about the Lord their God. Instead, they served the idols of B\_\_\_\_\_ and Asherah. (Judges 3:7)
5. The Lord was angry with Israel. He a\_\_\_\_\_ Cushan-Rishathaim king of Northwest Mesopotamia to rule over the Israelites. They were under that king's rule for e\_\_\_\_\_ years. (Judges 3:7)
6. Then Israel cried to the Lord. So the Lord sent a man to save them. He was Othniel son of Kenaz. (Kenaz was Caleb's younger brother.) O\_\_\_\_\_ saved the Israelites. (Judges 3:8)
7. The S\_\_\_\_\_ of the Lord entered Othniel. And he became Israel's judge and went to war. The Lord helped him to defeat Cushan-Rishathaim king of Northwest Mesopotamia. (Judges 3:9)
8. So the land was at peace for \_\_\_\_ years. Then Othniel son of Kenaz died. (Judges 3:11)
9. Again the people of Israel did what the Lord said was w\_\_\_\_\_. So the Lord gave E\_\_\_\_\_ king of Moab power to defeat Israel. This was because of the evil Israel did. (Judges 3:12)
10. The people of Israel were under the rule of Eglon king of M\_\_\_\_\_ for 18 years. (Judges 3:14)
11. So the people c\_\_\_\_\_ to the Lord. And he sent a man to save them. That man was E\_\_\_\_\_, who was left-handed. (Judges 3:15)
12. Ehud made a s\_\_\_\_\_ for himself. The sword had two edges and was about 18 inches long. He tied the sword to his r\_\_\_\_\_ upper leg under his clothes. (Judges 3:16)
13. So that day Moab was forced to be under the rule of Israel. And there was peace in the land for \_\_\_\_ years. (Judges 3:30)
14. After Ehud, another man saved Israel. His name was Shamgar son of Anath. Shamgar killed 600 P\_\_\_\_\_ with a sharp s\_\_\_\_\_ used to guide oxen. (Judges 3:31)
